Comeback to Church Plan

We look forward to worshipping with you here at the Place of Grace! We miss our GTM Family!

As we transition back to in-person worship, we want to first and foremost keep you and all the other members, new members, and guests safe!

We are adopting the CDC guidelines and the Texas minimum standard protocol for places of worship and a few additional standards to keep us safe as possible as God does the rest.

We will use common sense and wisdom to keep ourselves safe.

We know now that the virus that causes COVID-19 can be spread to others by infected persons who have few or no symptoms. Even if an infected person is only mildly ill, the people they spread it to may become seriously ill or even die, especially if that person is 65 or older with pre-existing health conditions that place them at higher risk. Because of the hidden nature of this threat, everyone should rigorously follow the practices specified in these protocols, all of which facilitate a safe and measured reopening of Texas. The virus that causes COVID-19 is still circulating in our communities. We should continue to observe practices that protect everyone, including those who are most vulnerable.

Our responsibility as a church

Initially, we will begin our in-person worship service on Sundays only @ 10:30AM. We will continue to closely monitor COVID-19 in our community and return to midweek service as we deem appropriate. In the interim, Wednesday Bible study @ 7PM will continue via online streaming platforms only.

We are expecting to re-open Kid Grace, Graceland and Christian Education mid-June early July.

Everyone will enter the building through a limited amount of designated entrances, and we ask that you patiently follow this protocol.

We will dismiss the congregation by sections to maintain social distancing standards.

We will check temperatures upon entry. Anyone with a temp of 100 or greater we would ask that you voluntarily remove yourself. We will direct you to enjoy service via one of our various streaming and social media platforms.

You will be screened (a brief questionnaire) weekly. If screening results are consistently the same each week you return, there will be no need to continue screening. If, however, you miss a Sunday then you will be screened again upon your return.

If you have been out of the state, we ask that you enjoy service on one of our streaming platforms for the incubation period of 14 days.

We strongly encourage the at-risk population to watch or participate in the service remotely or enjoy worship on one of our streaming platforms. We will only use one entrance and exit for worship service.

Our responsibility as worshippers

We ask that you please work with us and our protocols to return to worship. We are navigating these uncharted waters together! Please be patient and arrive to church as early as possible to expedite the screening protocols prior to entering service. We ask that you conduct yourself as if you have COVID-19, this is the way we can keep everyone safe, especially those who are vulnerable.

- We ask that everyone wear masks
- We ask that you do all you can prior to entering the church to limit the use of restroom facilities. We will limit use to 2 persons at a time per bathroom.
- Water fountains will not be available

- If you are feeling sick or have a cough, fever, or shortness of breath, we ask that you please stay at home and enjoy service on one of our streaming platforms.
- If you have been exposed to the virus or have been previously diagnosed, we ask that you follow the CDC guidelines before returning to in-person worship and enjoy service on one of our streaming platforms.

Ensure proper spacing between attendees:

· Keep at least two empty seats (or six feet separation) between parties in any row, except for two or more members of the same household who can sit next to one another, with two seats (or six feet separation) empty on either side.

- Two people who are not members of the same household but who are attending together can sit adjacent to one another, with two seats (or six feet separation) empty on either side.

Alternate rows between attendees (every other row will be left empty)

- Seating will be clearly marked please follow the instructions of the sanctuary attendants and deacons.
- We ask that there be no contact between parishioners. That means no hugs, high fives, or handshakes we'll call it contactless church.
- The last responsibility is to praise and worship God with everything that is in you. Show Him gratitude with our praise and let the Holy Spirit have is way in our service.
